

Nationwide Members' Trip to Skardu Gilgit Baltistan

5 Days 4 Nights Tour Plan Saturday to Wednesday

22nd June Till 26th June, 2024

The Skardu Valley (وادی سکردو) is located in Gilgit-Baltistan region of Pakistan. The valley is about 10 km wide and 40 km long. It is at the confluence of the Shigar River and Indus River. Surrounded by the gigantic Karakoram and Himalayas ranges and with its nearby lakes, it is a top tourist destination in Pakistan.

Skardu lies about 2,500 meters above sea level, and is nestled amid the Karakoram Mountain range. This rugged terrain is home to some of the tallest peaks in the world including K2 – the world's second-highest mountain and Pakistan's highest mountain – and Nanga Parbat.

Skardu Valley is mostly known for its stunning natural beauty that includes majestic mountains, lakes, picturesque meadows, and the most famous cold desert. It is also a well-known spot for adventure activities like trekking, mountaineering, and also camping.

Members to reach ICMA Islamabad Centre on Friday, 21 June 2024 at 11:00 pm. Departure from ICMA Islamabad Centre at 12:00 am and will reach Batakundi passing through Naran around 7:00 am, Breakfast and rest for 03 hours, then will move towards Skardu. Hotel check in around 7:00 pm in Skardu.

Day 02:

Shigar Valley Main Attractions: Upper Kachura, Lower Kachura/ Lake Shangrilla, Shigar fort, Manthoka Waterfall, Safranga desert.

Day 03:

Departure to Basho Valley also known as Basho Meadows, a hidden gem near Skardu. This picturesque valley offers stunning views of lush green meadows, crystal-clear streams, and towering mountains. It's a perfect spot for hiking, photography, and enjoying the tranquility of nature.

Day 04:

Departure to Deosai National Park: Satpara Lake, Bara Pani, Kala Pani and Sheosar Lake

Day 05:

Departure from Skardu at 7:00 am and will reach ICMA Islamabad Centre at 9:00 pm.
